On behalf of the Plaintiff State of Florida in the above-captioned case, I hereby request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, that the parties to this case be granted an extension to and including May 31, 2017, within which to file exceptions to the Report of the Special Master, and supporting briefs. That report was filed on March 20, 2017. The parties' exceptions are currently due on May 4, 2017. Defendant State of Georgia has no objection to this request, so long as a reciprocal extension is granted for the replies and supporting briefs.
